**Alert deputy captures Carjacking Suspect**

Birmingham, Alabama 1/22/2010 - Yesterday after receiving a BOLO from Bibb County, Deputies responded to the Eastern Valley road area to try and locate two suspects that had robbed, pistol whipped a man and stole his car, a blue, 1990 Cadillac Deville in the Woodstock area of Bibb County.

The suspects were also reported traveling in a red Chevrolet pick up truck.

Almost three hours later a Jefferson County Sheriff's Detective traveling in the Brighton area saw a blue Cadillac with a Bibb County License Plate and conducted a felony traffic stop in the 1200 block of Lewis Avenue. Other Sheriff's patrol back units arrived and took the suspect into custody without incident.

Two guns believed used in the car jacking were found under the drivers side seat. Both weapons appeared to have blood on them. Other items stolen from the victim were recovered in the vehicle including the victims wallet, watch and other jewelry.

The suspect was identified as 29 year old Lewis Williams of Brighton. The suspect, vehicle and recovered stolen property were turned over to Woodstock police. The second suspect is still at large.

The victim was listed in stable condition at Bibb Medical center.
